

KUNENE - SKELETON COAST CONCESSION

Classic Wilderness Camp



Skeleton Coast Camp is situated in the heart of a 300 000ha private wilderness area in the Skeleton Coast Park. The camp, set out along the banks of the ephemeral Hoarusib River, has six Meru-style tents with spacious bedrooms and en-suite bathrooms; meals are served in the open-air 'dining room' under an ancient leadwood tree (weather permitting).



Full- or half-day excursions include nature drives and walks, or visits to the clay castles of the Hoarusib River, Rocky Point, the roaring dunes, lichen fields, Cape fur seal colonies, Himba villages and shipwreck sites. Secret water seeps attract wildlife, so guests can see desert-adapted elephant, gemsbok, springbok, giraffe, ostrich, brown hyaena, Hartmann's mountain zebra and occasionally lion and cheetah. The terrain is rugged and harsh; hence this camp is enjoyed by those who are looking for a true wilderness experience in one of the most spectacular settings in Africa.
